

Becoming a SCAN Certified Agent

1 Obtain a New Agent Contract

To be authorized to sell SCAN products, you must be affiliated with an Agency that contracts with SCAN and fully certified for the products you wish to sell. Your Agency will email our Contracting Team with your information to request a contract. You will then be emailed a contract via DocuSign to be completed electronically.

Contracting paperwork includes:

- Agent Contact Form
- Agent Agreement
- Current State Insurance License Numbers
- Signed W-9
- Agent Appointment Form



Licensing - You must have current Accident & Health licenses to sell SCAN plans. (must not expire within 45 days of contracting)



Errors & Omissions (E&O) - Agents must sign the Errors and Omissions Attestation of Coverage (must not expire within 45 days of contracting). Your minimum E&O policy must be written for \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate limit. After onboarding, agents are required to continue to maintain active E&O coverage.

2 Complete Your Training

- * All contracting paperwork must be received before you can begin your training
- * Completion of training required during Onboarding and Annually thereafter






SCAN Classic (HMO) is an HMO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in SCAN Health Plan depends on contract renewal. You must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium.

Insulin copayments listed in the Prescription Drug Coverage Table apply to members who do not receive "Extra Help" to pay for their prescription drugs. Your insulin copayment may change when you enter Catastrophic Coverage. To find out which insulins are covered by SCAN, review the most recent Drug List we provided electronically. Covered products include all insulin pens and vials listed under the class name "Insulins" in our Drug List. If you have questions about the Drug List, you can also call Member Services. Prescription copay/coinsurance may vary by plan, county, pharmacy type (e.g., Preferred or Standard, etc.), day supply, Part D benefit phase, or in members who receive "Extra Help." You can fill your prescriptions at any of our network pharmacies, but you may pay less at a Preferred pharmacy. Check your Evidence of Coverage or call Member Services for details (phone numbers for Member Services are printed on the back cover of your Evidence of Coverage).


You can get prescription drugs shipped to your home through our network mail-order delivery program. Express Scripts PharmacySM is our Preferred mail-order pharmacy. While you can fill your prescription medications at any of our network mail-order pharmacies, you may pay less at the Preferred mail-order pharmacy. Typically, you should expect to receive your prescription drugs within 14 days from the time that Express Scripts mail-order pharmacy receives the order. If you do not receive your prescription drug(s) within this time, please contact SCAN Health Plan's Member Services. For your mail-order prescriptions, you have the option to sign up for an automatic refill program by contacting Express Scripts Pharmacy at 1-866-553-4125, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. TTY users call 711. You may opt out of automatic deliveries at any time.

This prescription drug is not normally covered in a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan. The amount you pay when you fill a prescription for this drug does not count towards your total drug costs (that is, the amount you pay does not help you qualify for catastrophic coverage). In addition, if you are receiving extra help to pay for your prescriptions, you will not get any extra help to pay for this drug. This drug has a quantity limit of 4 tablets per 30 days (a maximum of 49 tablets per year).
